



### **Genesee Yacht Club Limited Clubhouse use guidelines**

The GYC Executive Board has considered member requests to allow limited use of the clubhouse. In the interest of everyone's safety, use of the club house is discouraged at the present time. However, it is allowed on a limited basis providing the following protocols are strictly observed. There will be updates as changes in the state and local guidelines occur.

This first phase opening criteria are based on pre-arranged gatherings, which will enable us to maintain an occupancy limit of 12 persons maximum. Each gathering requires a sponsor who assumes responsibility for enforcing the guidelines.

1. Gathering sponsors will need to accept responsibility for the conduct of their guests and for following GYC guidelines and protocols.
2. The responsible member (hereafter called the sponsor or group leader), will be responsible for conducting the attached health screening questionnaire for all attendees, attesting that all members have passed the screening, taking and recording attendance, and ensuring compliance with all requirements listed here.
3. Gathering times will be restricted to one in the morning (8-11 am) and one the evening (4-11 pm), with at least a four-hour gap in between.
4. The sponsor must sign-up for the gathering: [Link to GYC Clubhouse Limited Use Sign-up](#)
5. Gatherings shall not exceed 12 participants.
6. The sponsor must ensure that all hard surfaces have been disinfected both before and after use, per the posted instructions.
7. All participants should wash/sanitize their hands upon arrival and whenever returning to their table.
8. Masks covering the mouth and nose must be worn the entire time you are inside the building, except when eating. Food and beverages are only to be consumed when seated at your table.
9. Standard six feet or more social distancing is to be observed at all times.
10. Seating configurations must be consistent with distancing requirements, see example. To facilitate effective disinfection, only the 12 metal porch chairs are to be used. Do not use the upholstered chairs.
11. Rooms that are open -
  - a. Open: main meeting room, Bathrooms, Foyer/Entrance area and hallway.
  - b. Closed: The captain's room and kitchen are strictly off limits. No use of any kitchen items is permitted.



12. Carry in/carry out everything you intend to use. Remove your garbage when you leave, use the outdoor dumpster or take it with you. Disposable items encouraged.
13. Use of ceiling fans or other fans is prohibited.

Health Screening Questionnaire: (A “yes” answer to any question prohibits the member from entry until they are symptom free for 72 hours and have tested negative for COVID 19.)

Do you currently have any of the following symptoms that are new or unusual for you?

1. Fever or fever like symptoms?
2. Severe headache
3. Cough
4. Runny nose
5. Sore throat
6. Diarrhea/vomiting/nausea
7. Loss of taste or smell
8. In the past 21 days, have you been exposed to anyone who has tested positive for COVID 19?
9. In the past 21 days, have you tested positive for COVID 19, or have results pending?
10. In the past 30 days, have you travelled to any high risk regions or outside of the US?
