

Watering the Lawn

Hello all-

I have posted a new SignUpGenius list for watering the sod. There are two shifts per day through August. Each shift should take approx 90 minutes to fully water. The link to the SignUpGenius is:

This is a really good opportunity for anyone who needs work hours. There are over 170 opportunities to sign up and over 250 hours. Following are Hans' directions for watering.

The lawn is looking good. We need to keep watering and stay off the turf.

When watering, make sure the edges and corners are covered.

The lawn area on the river can be reached without stepping on the lawn, from the parking lot and the boardwalk. Make sure the edges corners get watered!

For the lawn along the basin you can drag the hose over the lawn.

The lawn needs a good soaking every day. Overwatering is not a problem. 750 to 1000 gallons is good. Depending on the water pressure and flow rate this can take 1.5 to 2.5 hours.

There is a hose by the mast hoist that connects to the red garage hose.

There is a green hose by the flagpole (the faucet handle on this hose is loose and needs pliers to shut off).

There is a red hose at the south end of the basin boardwalk.

If you use sprinklers make sure the edges and corners are covered!
